At this time, we can return the books, because we know more about the transmission factor of the virus. In the early days, it was suggested that it could be transmitted via surface touch. Now, we believe that there is minimal risk of that (thought not 0%) However, we still know that the virus is spread through the air and aerosol.

Therefore, at this time,

.....masks are still required,

.....sanitizing hands is still required,

.... no chalice/no wine during Eucharist,

.....no singing,

.....no passing of the Peace.

I hope this fully answers the ongoing questions.
