As previously announced, we will be voting on changes to the Christ Church bylaws at the annual meeting this Sunday following the 10 am combined service. If the vote is to change to a seven-person vestry, we will then need to elect two new vestry members to a three-year term and one vestry member to a one-year term. If the vote is to continue with a nine-person vestry, then we need to elect a total of five new vestry members (three for three-year terms and two for one-year terms).

Anyone elected to a one-year term will be eligible to run again for a three-year term in December of 2020.
